Good afternoon,

This will serve as the FINAL SITREP for the Beaver Dam Explosion. The Command Post has ceased operations. A final briefing was held at BDPD at 10am with all partner agencies. All further investigative activity will be handled from FBI Milwaukee.

Be advised, during a final bomb sweep, it was determined residual chemicals remained from the original blast which caused a minor detonation. As such, all bomb sweeps have ceased. Local Emergency Management was contacted. The area will be secured as a plan to remediate the issue is pursued. Once the plan is developed, bomb techs will return onsite to assist as needed.

Thanks to all participating agencies for your exceptional efforts on this incident.

Building Integrity

109 Knaup Drive.

The safety of the affected area is our primary focus, with every effort being made to maintain the safety of the entire complex, and its residents.

Based on current investigations, there are still on-going concerns about remnant explosive materials that still may be inside the entire building. Investigative findings and structural concerns, the building has been determined a complete loss. Immediate plans are being made for total removal of this building.

The focus of our attention is still, and will remain at the 109 Knaup Dr. apartment complex. The surrounding buildings have been deemed safe, and occupancy of those building can be maintained. Because of the nature of everything that has occurred to this point, law enforcement will continue to maintain perimeter security of the 109 Knaup Drive building to further ensure the safety of the public.

The Beaver Dam Police Department, along with Dodge County Emergency Management encourages anyone who wants to support the displaced families in building 109, to make monetary donations at any Horicon Bank, within Dodge County. All donations can be made payable to Dodge County COAD/Beaver Dam Apartment. All funds will be used to assist the residents of building 109.





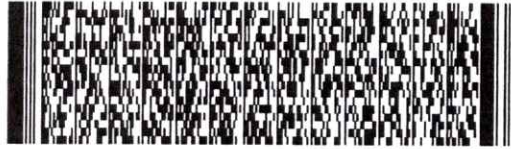
